Young Producers Internship

About This Role

As a Young Producer, you will:

- Take part in a paid internship supported by Chol Theatre and The Children's Art School, learning the skills to produce and deliver a week long Teen Takeover festival during February half term 2026.
- Work collaboratively to design and plan a programme of creative events and activities for young people in Kirklees.
- Learn practical skills in event production, including planning, budgeting, marketing, team coordination, and audience engagement.
- Gain practical experience during the Teen Takeover week (based in Huddersfield town centre), supporting the delivery of workshops, performances, and celebrations.
- Receive mentoring and training from experienced professionals in arts production, marketing, and community engagement.
- Be part of a supportive creative team that values every voice, encourages collaboration, and champions inclusivity and wellbeing.

Remuneration

This is a part-time, flexible internship designed to work around your existing commitments (such as college, university, work, or caring responsibilities).

Daily rate: £93.75 per day (up to 7.5 hours per day)

Total: 10 paid days (£937.50 total)

Expenses: Travel expenses will be covered

Availability

- You must be available for all 5 days during February half term (Monday - Friday) to deliver the Teen Takeover event.
- The remaining 5 days will take place between December 2025 and February 2026 with flexible scheduling for planning meetings, training, and creative development sessions.
- Some sessions will be in person in Kirklees, with additional tasks that can be completed independently around your own schedule.

You might be:

- Interested in producing, music, theatre, film, or creative events.
- Someone who enjoys organising, planning, or bringing people together.
- Passionate about creativity, community, and giving young people a platform.
- Open minded, enthusiastic, and willing to learn new skills.
- Keen to work as part of a supportive and diverse team.
- You don't need any previous experience, just a commitment to working collaboratively and creatively.
- We are an equal opportunities company and know that diversity strengthens and enriches. We strongly encourage applications from all backgrounds, particularly from global majority backgrounds and disabled applicants, neurodivergent people, and those from working-class backgrounds.
